Chaperone Job description



Requirements

- Adult leaders must have participated regularly in the life of the congregation for at least 3 months before serving as a Chaperone.
- Adult leaders who regularly work with youth must sign necessary forms and submit to a background check at any given time.
- Be a Christian in good standing and have a heart for youth ministry
- Adhere to the principles and ideas developed by the Youth Pastor and Youth Team
- Must be a year removed from high school
- Cannot be in a dating relationship with a current student.

Expectations

- Be supportive and positive of Youth Pastor and Youth Team Members
- Be available to chaperone youth events and services during the year as your schedule allows.
- Notify Youth Pastor in advance (preferably at least 24 hours before services and 2 weeks before events) if you committed prior to attend an event and for unknown reason are unable to attend
- Follow up on commitments made to Youth Pastor or Youth Team leaders.
- Provide assistance, transportation, observation, and support during events and services.
- If for any reason you are no longer able to serve as chaperone please inform Youth Pastor as soon as possible
- Be a Godly role model in all aspects of your life.
